### **BRIDGES FOR THE GOSPEL**

*Silk Road Pilgrimage*, Pilgrim David, 2012: Wide Margin, Gloucester, UK. Excellent book to help us learn to look for redemptive analogies in the cultures to whom we minister. On the journey of life, none of us know what is around the next bend. All of us need guidance and wisdom from the One who knows our final destination and how to get there. This book takes us on two journeys: one is a physical journey, through the lands of Central Asia and the Caucasus, but on the way, we also find ourselves on a journey of spiritual discovery. In the course of conversations with people along the Silk Road, our eyes are opened to new truths that we might not have noticed but are actually all around us. We will discover that, for the one who has eyes to see, our cultures and some of our traditions, like circumcision or the paying of *kalym*—and even the carpets under our feet!—can act as signposts on the way to the Mountain of God.

*The Attack Lambs: Prayer That Changes the World*, Mark Geppert, 2009 Genesis Books, Singapore.

Learn bold strategies needed to combat the four forces of darkness. Everything hinges on defeating these four. Three essential disciplines to do effective spiritual warfare. Identify the five pressure points that change cities and nations. An army of worshipping warriors can impact a lost and troubled world.

*The Kingdom and the Power*, Gary S. Greig and Kevin N. Springer, 1993 Regal Books, Ventura, CA.

Fifteen evangelical scholars and church leaders deal with the critics of power ministries and build solid biblical, theological, exegetical, historical, pastoral, anthropological, and medical bases for the validity and crucial place of healing and spiritual gifts in evangelism and in church ministry today.

*Power Evangelism*, John Wimber and Kevin Springer, 1992 Harper & Row, San Francisco, CA.

A direct application of the role that signs and wonders can have in evangelistic work written by John Wimber, the Vineyard leader who hammered out a new view, known now as the third wave view, of Spirit baptism, the gifts of the Spirit, of training and deploying laypeople with a biblically based, practical t-step model of prayer for healing, and who emphasized the strategic place of healing, and spiritual gifts of evangelism. Wimber also introduced these views in the world famous course, MC510 “Signs, Wonders, and Church Growth” to Fuller Seminary in the early 1980’s.

*These Signs Shall Follow: The Miraculous Memoirs of a Foot Dragging Disciple*, Neil W. Gamble, 2013, Charleston, SC. Neil shares experiences with Jesus over the last 30 years

and the lessons he learned pursuing the naturally supernatural expression of Christianity the Bible calls us to live out. Neil is an international trainer/teacher/speaker involved in the discipleship/house church planting movement. His book shares simple principles of discipleship and intimacy with the Father, Son and Holy Spirit that he models.

*Multiplying Churches Through Prayer Cell Evangelism—A Manual for Church Planting Movements*, Dr. Alex. G. Smith, 2003, OMF International.

A manual originally birthed in through missions efforts in Thailand but expanded now to many other nations with the goal of multiplying churches throughout nations and people groups.

*Prayer Evangelism: How to Change the Spiritual Climate Over Your Home, Neighborhood and City*, Ed Silvano, 2000: Chosen Books, Bloomington, MN. As a result of the growing worldwide prayer movement, powerful changes have taken place in the church and in scattered cities' transformations beyond anything imaginable only a few years ago. Of the revelations to come out of this movement, perhaps the most dramatic and promising is the rediscovery of biblical principles for changing the spiritual climate over entire cities and regions. Fulfillment of the Great Commission is no longer a distant hope but rather a fast-approaching reality for a worldwide church that will take hold of and use the biblical principles for changing cities as described in *Prayer Evangelism*. Silvano shares his heart and his passion for reaching cities the way the early church did it: the whole church modeling the whole gospel to the whole city through prayer and prayerful evangelism.
